



## **Basketball Alberta Midget Zone Team – Head Coach Job Description**

The Basketball Alberta Midget Zone Team programs provide a spectacular experience, providing athletes the opportunity to play with other talented athletes from their zone in Alberta. Alberta is split into eight (8) zones across the province and each fields a team to compete during the summer months.

The program begins with open tryouts in May, where the top athletes in each zone will be identified for the teams. The zone teams will train throughout the month of July in preparation for the Alberta Zone Provincial Championships.

### The program seeks to:

- Produce elite athletes through the development and enhancement of fundamental skills;
- Produce elite coaches through enhanced coaching education, and provide a pathway to reach the provincial/national level;
- Identify, select and train athletes and coaches who will contribute to the zone's future provincial success;
- Identify, select and train athletes and coaches who will contribute to Alberta's future national success;
- Identify, select and train athletes and coaches who will eventually contribute to Canada's future international success.

### The services to be provided by the Head Coach include:

- Athlete identification;
- Curriculum delivery under the leadership;
- On-court instruction of athletes at all team training sessions;
- Ongoing monitoring of athletes physical training and skills;
- Communication and meetings with assigned athletes;
- Final evaluation of assigned athletes and final report.

### Coaches interested in the Head Coach Position should have the following qualifications:

- Complete Basketball Alberta Community Coaching Clinic
- Attend all scheduled team training sessions;

- Ability to work cooperatively with assistant coaches;
- Ability to deliver a provincial curriculum to athletes in an effective manner;
- Ability to promote the Midget Zone Team program and act in a professional manner as a representative of Basketball Alberta.

The try-outs will be held in May 2010 and training/competition will continue through July and August 2010. This is a contract position with remuneration dependent on qualifications.
